

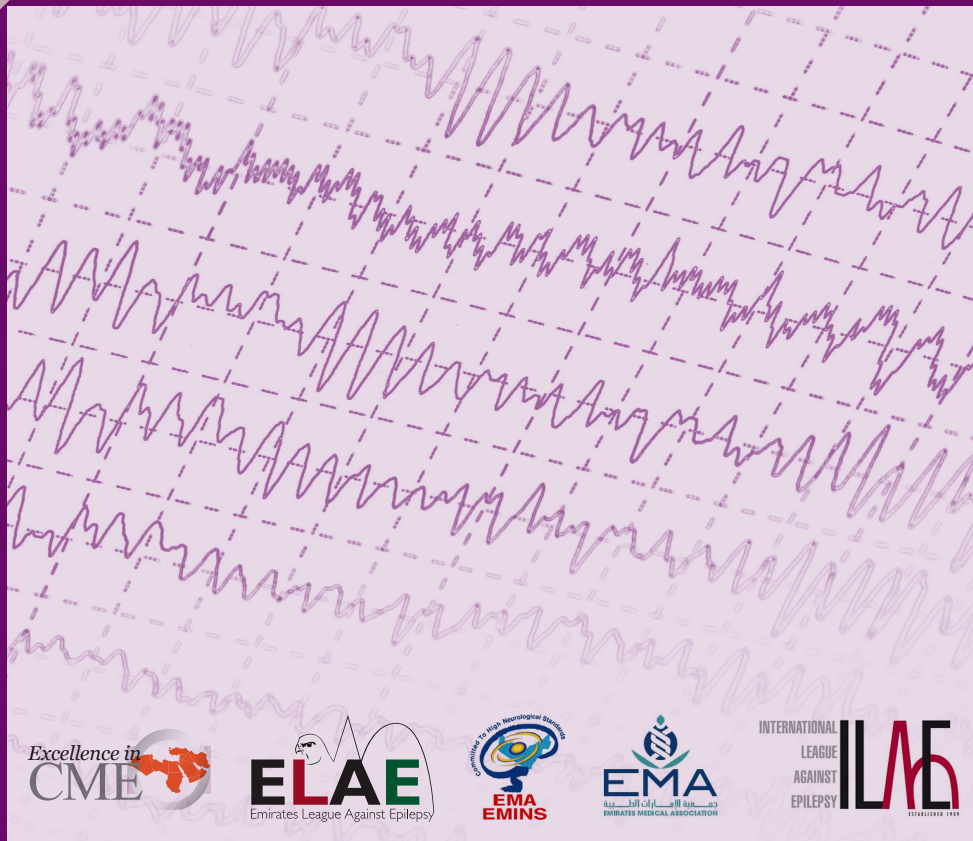

Dear friends and colleagues,



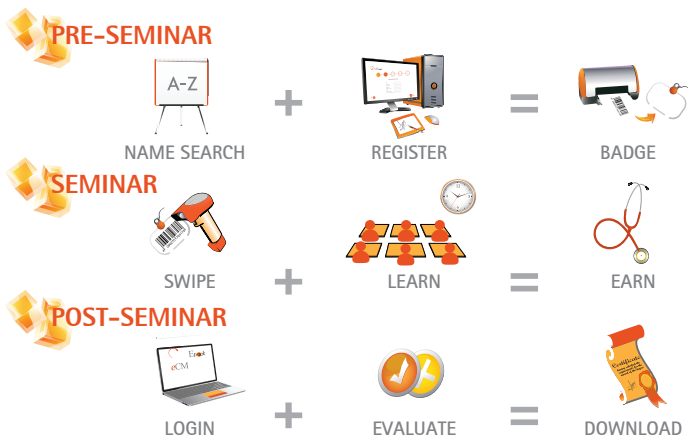

Conference Speakers

Prof. Ahmad Beydoun, MD

Professor of Neurology
American University of Beirut

Dr. Beydoun is currently Professor of Neurology at the American University of Beirut Medical Center and Director of the comprehensive adult and pediatric epilepsy program. After completing his clinical neurophysiology fellowship at the University of Michigan, Dr. Beydoun stayed on as a faculty member at that institution and went up the rank to eventually become a Professor of Neurology and director of the comprehensive epilepsy program at the University of Michigan.



Dr. Beydoun is an internationally known epileptologist, with more than 90 peer reviewed articles in addition to multiple book chapters. He has participated as the principal investigator in more than 50 clinical trials evaluating the efficacy and safety of a number of investigational anti-epileptic drugs. He is currently the president of the Lebanese League against epilepsy and the president of the ILAE Commission of Eastern Mediterranean Affairs. Dr. Beydoun has lectured extensively worldwide and his current research interest beside outcomes of epilepsy surgery is focused on a large prospective study of patients with newly diagnosed epilepsy.

Prof. Hassan Hosny, MD

Professor of Neurology
Cairo University

Prof. Hassan Hosny is currently a full Professor of Neurology at Cairo University (since 2000). After completing his residency training at Cairo University hospitals, he left to the USA where he completed fellowships in clinical Neurophysiology and epilepsy at the University of Chicago and the Cleveland clinic foundation (1988-1991). Dr Hosny's main interest is Epilepsy as well as movement disorders, pain, headache and dementia.



He is the president of the Egyptian epilepsy Association which he founded in 2004. He works closely with the international league against epilepsy (ILAE) where he is a member of the commission on East Mediterranean affairs (CEMA). He also sits on the board of the Educational and Epilepsy care commissions of the ILAE. Dr Hosny is also a member of the Editorial board of the international journal of Epilepsy Research. He organized several successful international epilepsy congresses in Sharm ElSheikh in 2003 and in Luxor in 2007, an EEG course in 2009, Epilepsy meeting on Status Epilepticus in 2010 in Luxor and international neurology meeting

Prof. Cigdem Ozkara, MD

Professor of Neurology
University of Istanbul

Graduated from Bursa, Uludag University, Medical Faculty in 1984, worked in different cities in Anatolia for compulsory service for two years and completed neurology training in Bakirkoy State Hospital for Neurological and Psychiatric disorders in 1991. After receiving William G. Lennox International Clinical Research Fellowship provided by American Epilepsy Foundation (EFA), worked in University of Virginia, Achieved associate professorship in 1996 and full professorship in 2002 at Istanbul University . Since then working at Istanbul University, Cerrahpasa Medical School, department of Neurology, Division of Clinical Electrophysiology, Epilepsy – EEG section and running an epilepsy outpatient clinic and Epilepsy Surgery program.



Prof. Ozkara served for Turkish Epilepsy Society as secretary and president and ILAE as member of different commissions and EUREPA and secretary for ILAE European commission. Published many papers on epilepsy in national and international journals and wrote chapters for epilepsy books. Involved in organization of many national and international meetings. Serving in the editorial board of journals: Seizure, Epileptic Disorders, Epileptology –Facts & Controversies , Epileptologia, Epilepsi (Tr) . She was awarded as “ambassador for epilepsy ” in 2009.

Prof. Emilio Perucca, MD

President-elect ILAE, Professor of Medical Pharmacology
University of Pavia

Emilio Perucca trained as a clinical pharmacologist and neurologist in London, England, where he obtained a PhD in 1980. He is currently Professor of Medical Pharmacology at the University of Pavia, Director of the Clinical Trial Center at the National Institute of Neurology IRCCS C Mondino Foundation in Pavia, Italy and Coordinator for Clinical Research at IDEE (Institut des Epilepsies de l'Enfant e de l'Adolescent), Claude Bernard University Lyon 1, Lyon, France.



He is a Member of the Management Committee and of the Executive committee of the International League against Epilepsy (ILAE), and President-Elect of ILAE for the 2013-2017 term. He is also a member of the Editorial / Advisory Boards of several journals, including Epilepsia, Epileptic Disorders, Epilepsy Research, Seizure, CNS Drugs, Lancet Neurology, Clinical Pharmacokinetics, and Acta Neurologica Scandinavica. In 1997 he received the ILAE-IBE Ambassador for Epilepsy Award. His research interests have focused mainly on the treatment of epilepsy and outcome assessment in epilepsy. He has co-edited several international textbooks and authored/co-authored about 400 Pubmed-listed articles in the field of clinical pharmacology and epilepsy therapy.

Prof. Eugen Trinka, MD

Professor and Chair of the Department of Neurology
Paracelsus Medical University



Professor Eugen Trinka qualified in Medicine at Vienna University in 1990 and undertook his postgraduate training in Salzburg before becoming a staff neurologist in 1998. Dr Trinka pursued fellowship training at the Montreal Neurological Institute with Prof. Frederick Andermann and Dr. Francois Dubeau. Since 2003 he has been Associate Professor of Neurology at the Innsbruck Medical University and he became Head of the Epilepsy Service and EEG Laboratory at the Department of Neurology, University Hospital Innsbruck, 2004 to 2010. Professor Trinka is President of the Austrian Society for Clinical Neurophysiology and President Elect of the Society of Epilepsy Surgery centres in Germany, Austria and Switzerland. In 2009 Dr. Trinka has been elected as an Executive member of the Commission on European Affairs of the International League Against Epilepsy (CEA-ILAE), where he serves as the treasurer. In addition he is a founding member and vice president of the European Epilepsy Monitoring Unit Association. Dr. Trinka also serves on the ILAE Task force of Classification of Status Epilepticus and the ILAE Working group on pre-clinical drug discovery.

Dr. Trinka has been dedicated to the education and postgraduate training of students and fellows since the beginning of his career. He is currently involved in the educational programme of the CEA-ILAE, which organises, topical courses, regional courses, as well as advanced postgraduate courses in clinical epileptology, throughout Europe.

Dr. Raida Al-Baradie, MD

Consultant Pediatric Neurologist
KFSH-D & Dammam University



Dr. Raidah Al-Baradie trained in pediatric neurology and epilepsy in Harvard medical School, Boston Children Hospital and she obtained American Board of Psychiatry and Neurology with special qualification in child neurology in 2006. She is currently a Consultant Pediatric Neurologist/ Epileptologist at King Fahd Specialist Hospital- Dammam & Dammam University, Director Comprehensive Epilepsy Program at KFSH-D & Chairman of Pediatric Neurology KFSH-D.

She is a President of Saudi Chapter of Epilepsy & Vice president of Saudi Epilepsy Society. She is the representative of Global Campaign of International League against Epilepsy in Mediterranean Region. She is also a member of the Editorial / Advisory Boards of several journals, including Neurosciences and European Pediatric Neurology Journal. Her research interest has focused mainly on clinical aspects of related to epilepsy. She has multiple abstracts and national and international publications.

Dr. Mohamad Al Malik, MD

Head of Pediatric Neurology Department
Tawam Hospital

Dr. Al-Malik is currently consultant pediatric neurologist at Tawam hospital, Al Ain and head of the pediatric neurology division. Clinical Ass. Professor, Faculty of Medicine, UAE University.



Completed his Pediatric, Pediatric Neurology and Neurodisability training at King Khalid university hospital in Riyadh, (KSA) and Children's hospital of the Leicester Royal Infirmary, UK. He got the membership and fellowship of the Royal College of pediatric and child Health and he got his Certificate of Completion of specialized training from University hospitals of Leicester (UK).

Before joining Tawam hospital, he worked as Consultant Paediatrician and neurologist with special interest In Neurodisability and Epilepsy as well as clinical senior lecturer, Sheffield University UK.

Dr. Taoufik Alsaadi, MD

Dr. Alsaadi is a senior consultant and the Head of the Neurology Department at Sheikh Khalifa Medical City. He was trained in Epilepsy and Clinical Neurophysiology at the University of California San Francisco, and was a research fellow in Epilepsy there. He is board-certified by the American Board of Psychiatry and Neurology and by the American Board of Clinical Neurophysiology.



Before coming to Abu Dhabi, Dr. Alsaadi was an associate Professor of Neurology and the Director of the Adult Epilepsy Program and the Clinical Research Program at the University of California Davis. His research has focused on conducting drug study trials for new anti-epileptic agents for patients with epilepsy, quality of life in patients with epileptic and non epileptic disorders, neuroimaging and electroencephalographic predictors of outcome from epilepsy surgery. He also has a special interest in utilizing various neuroimaging techniques in studying seizure disorders, particularly MR spectroscopy and fMRI. Dr. Alsaadi has been honored with several prestigious awards for his work in the field of epilepsy. He has served on the Advisory Board of the Northern California Epilepsy Foundation and on the membership committee of the American Epilepsy Society. He has served as the President of the Western Clinical Neurophysiology Society in the United States. He is currently the president of the Emirates League against epilepsy and he also serves in the Editorial Board for BMC Journal of Neurology and Journal of Neurosciences. He has authored and co-authored more than 30 papers and book chapters, and has served as a peer-reviewer for more than 15 scientific journals.

Dr. Hamza Alsayouf, MD

Consultant Pediatric Neurologist

Dr Alsayouf is currently working as consultant child neurologist at Mafraq hospital in Abu Dhabi, UAE. He joined the department of child neurology in January 2012. He did his Pediatric training at Texas Tech University at Amrillo, 2002-2005. Then he joined Nationwide Children's hospital as Child neurology fellow of Ohio State University from 2006 to 2009. Mafraq Hospital

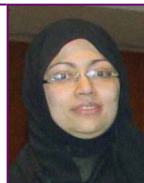

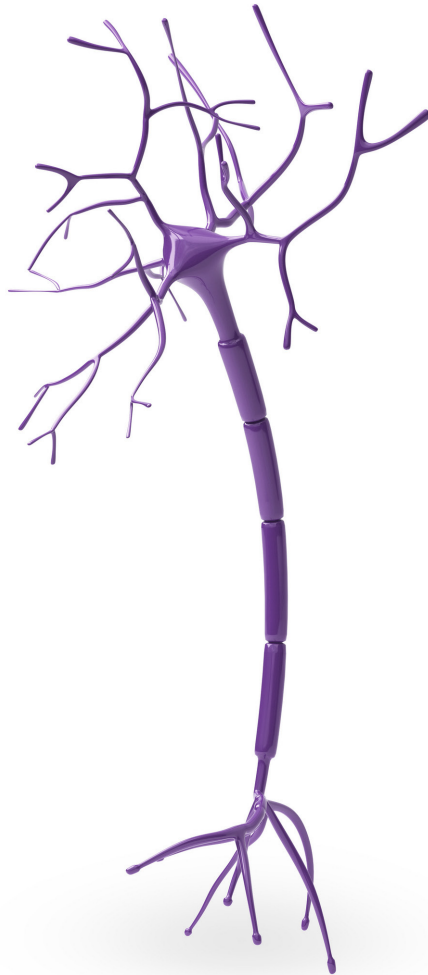
Dr. Imad Saadledin, MD
