- 01 Recognize that a normal serum creatinine does not rule out significant renal pathology, and identify clinical clues that warrant further renal work-up in rheumatology patients.
- 02 Apply a practical “renal toolkit” (labs, urinalysis, imaging, and biopsy triggers) to support diagnosis and monitoring of kidney involvement in rheumatic disease.
- 03 Interpret and manage case-based presentations of lupus nephritis, integrating clinical, serologic, and histopathologic findings into treatment decisions.
- 04 Rapidly triage and problem-solve common and atypical renal complications encountered in rheumatology practice, including drug-induced and disease-related kidney injury.
- 05 Recognize renal emergencies requiring urgent nephrology referral, and apply a red-flag checklist to guide timely, appropriate escalation of care.
