WORKSHOP OBJECTIVES

By the end of this workshop, participants will be able to:

- 01 Recognize the major pulmonary manifestations of systemic lupus erythematosus (SLE).
- 02 Approach SLE-related thoracic disease anatomically, including the pleura, lung parenchyma, airways, pulmonary vasculature, and diaphragm.
- 03 Identify the characteristic imaging patterns on chest X-ray and HRCT associated with SLE.
- 04 Differentiate important SLE pulmonary complications such as acute lupus pneumonitis, diffuse alveolar hemorrhage, ILD, pulmonary embolism, pulmonary hypertension, and shrinking lung syndrome.
- 05 Recognize important mimics and differential diagnoses, particularly infection, pulmonary edema, and thromboembolic disease.
- 06 Understand the role and limitations of imaging, emphasizing correlation with clinical findings, laboratory results, PFTs, echocardiography, and prior imaging.
